**MIN 1/13/02/2024: INTRODUCTION**

**MIN 2/13/02/2024: OPENING REMARKS**

The Municipal Manager welcomed everybody present. He asked the citizens to focus more on development and improvement of the quality of life within the Municipality.

**MIN 3/13/02/2024: STREETS NAMING & PROJECTS/PROGRAMS UPDATE.**

**(a) Rumuruti Streets Naming**

- The citizens present were guided by the County Physical Planner in naming all the streets and roads within the Municipality.

**(b) Ngomongo Bridge Project**

- The above project is now at 100% complete awaiting official launch.

**(c) Urban planning updates:**

- The final Local Physical & Land Use Development Plan 2021-2031 has been approved by Laikipia County Assembly.

**MIN 4/13/02/2024: PLENARY SESSION**

The Plenary session was conducted by the Municipal Manager. The citizens raised the following concerns:

- Rumuruti youths should be given employment opportunities at the CAIP project
- Justice and transparency should prevail in service delivery
- Complains/grievances should be forwarded to the office of the Municipal Manager.
- Citizens should cooperate with Government on ensuring projects sustainability.
- Each village should have a development committee representative.
- Citizens should assist Government in curbing security lights theft.
- Citizens should be strategic in business opportunities uptake now that the county headquarters has relocated to Rumuruti.
- Government should ensure fairness and transparency when allocating land to Citizens.
