Call for Application: Veterinarians for Laikipia County FMD & PPR Vaccination Campaign through the E-Voucher System under the FSRP Project

Deadline: 27th August, 2025

The Laikipia County Government in collaboration with Food System Resilience Project and the Directorate of Veterinary Services, invite qualified and licensed Veterinarians and Para-Veterinarians to apply for participating in the upcoming Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) and Peste des Petits Ruminants (PPR) vaccination campaign. This initiative will be implemented through the e-voucher system, ensuring efficient service delivery and transparent compensation.

Objectives of the Campaign

- To enhance livestock health and productivity across Kenya
- To prevent and control outbreaks of FMD and PPR
- To strengthen veterinary service delivery through digital platforms

Who Should Apply

Licensed Veterinarians and Para-Veterinarians who;

- Are registered with the Kenya Veterinary Board (KVB)
- Are familiar with digital tools and mobile -based service delivery
- Are available for deployment between September and November 2025

Responsibilities

- Administer FMD and PPR vaccines to targeted livestock populations
- Record and report vaccination data via the e-voucher system
- Registration of animals through digital platform
- Engage with livestock owners and local stakeholders
- Ensure cold chain and vaccine integrity throughout the campaign period

Remuneration

- VPPs Ksh.24 per head of cattle vaccinated and Kshs. 3 per sheep /goat vaccinated
- VSs Ksh.8 per head of cow vaccinated and Kshs. 1 per sheep/ goat vaccinated
- Target animals in Laikipia County are 300,000 cattle and 800,000 shoats

E-Voucher System

Selected Veterinarians will be onboarded on to the FSRP e-voucher platform, which will;

- Facilitate service tracking and reporting
- Enable timely payments for services rendered
- Provide real-time data for monitoring and evaluation
